This academic year had to witness certain prominent alterations introduced by the CBSE Board. Latest pedagogical patterns emphasising the scheme of annual examination pattern was implemented in a very successful way thus updating and enhancing the quality of education. The new system does away with the practice of awarding grades and replaces it with marks. Scholastic performance evaluated through written examinations will carry greater weightage than the combination of periodic tests, notebook submission and subject enrichment activity. The new system also aims to bring about uniformity in the pattern of examination across all CBSE schools. CBSE has made it mandatory for all students from Classes IX to XII to study Health & Physical Education (HPE) subject. The students will have to go to playground to play any sports and will be graded for that. Therefore, CBSE aims to provide a focussed curriculum for Health and Physical Education imbued with Life Skills in all its affiliated schools.

Let me embark upon the performance of our school under review. The school reopened on the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2018 after the mid-summer vacation. New resolutions were taken to enhance the smooth functioning of the school. the KG section reopened on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The classes for plus one commenced on June 20<sup>th</sup> 2018. the current strength of our school is 845. There are 43 teaching staff and 12 non teaching staff. The achievements of the past year bear testimony to their commitment to academic and overall excellence.
